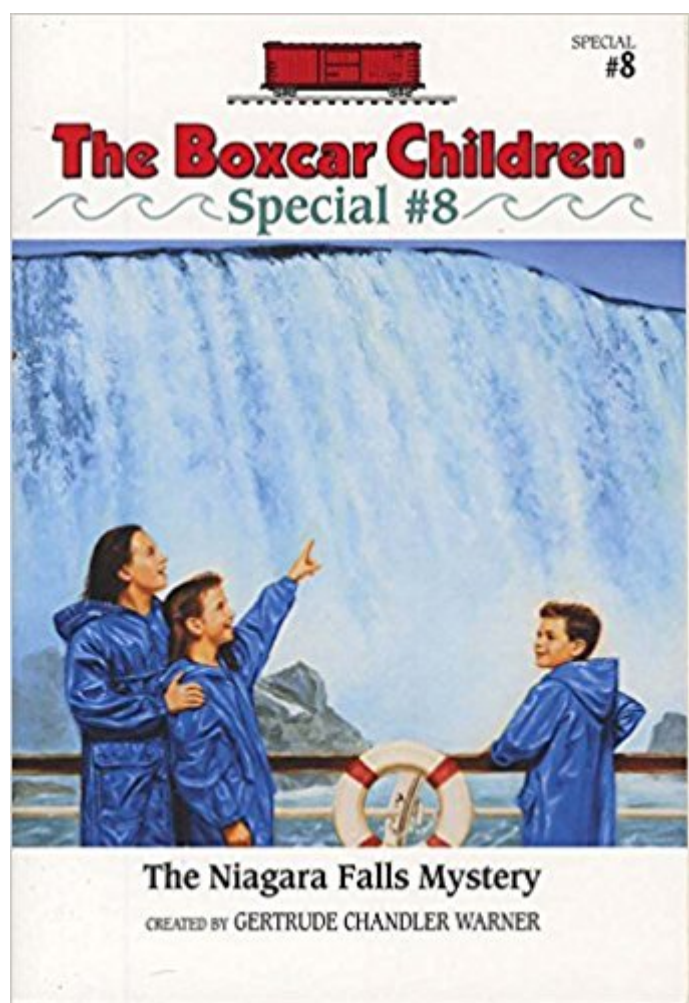


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The Niagara Falls Mystery (The Boxcar Children Mystery & Activities Specials)
