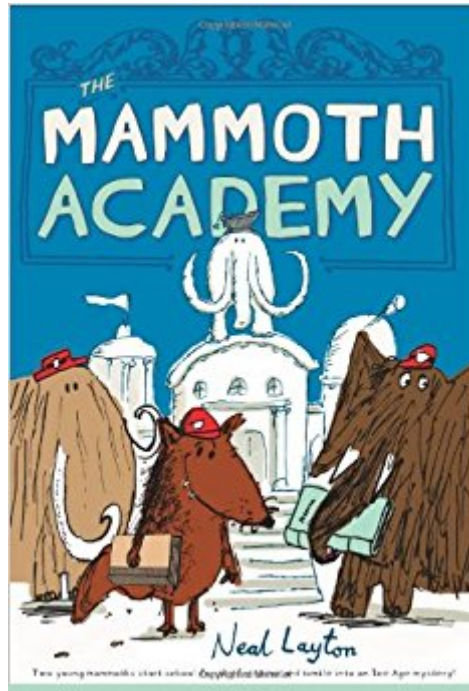

Grade 3 "5" The protagonists of Layton's picture books Oscar and Arabella (Hodder, 2003) and Hot Hot Hot (Candlewick, 2004) return, this time in a beginning-chapter-book format. The woolly mammoths are summoned to start school at the Mammoth Academy. Despite its name, all varieties of Ice Age animals attend, and Oscar soon finds a good friend in Fox. Arabella, unfortunately, remains a minor character. Fox says one day in gym that he's heard from a warthog that if you don't bathe for two months, your fur begins to clean itself, and he has decided not to wash anymore. Soon he stinks so badly that the other animals (except for Oscar) keep their distance. But when Fox and Oscar discover a cave filled with terrifying, club-wielding humans who plan to capture and consume the students and teachers, only Fox's odor and Oscar's invention of the first
