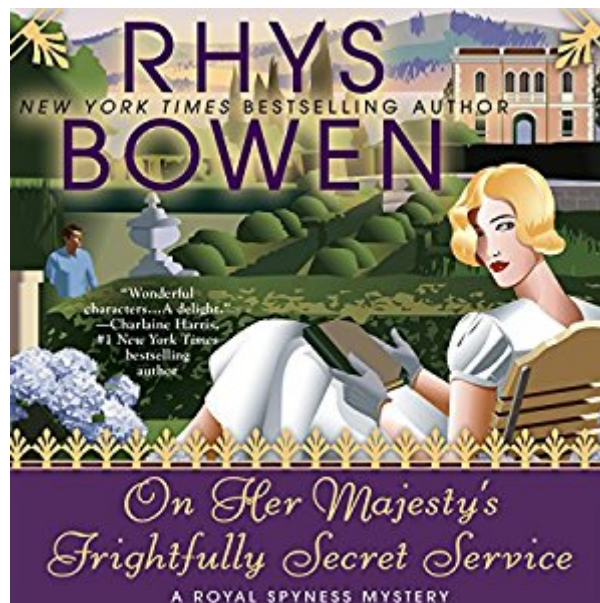




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On Her Majesty's Frightfully Secret Service: A Royal Spyness Mystery, Book 11
