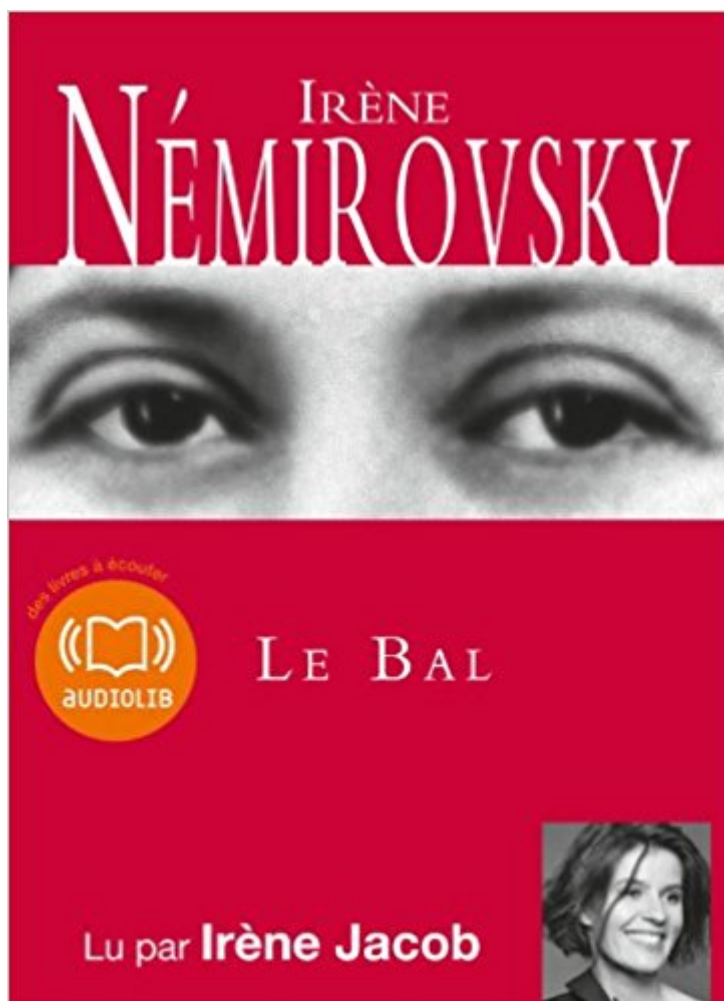

After Irene, the author and husband are dead in Auschwitz, their children are smuggled to Switzerland. After the war, some soul tries to re-unite the two orphan children with grandma. She won't open the door and tells the children to go to an orphanage.

In this early book, I could see the talents and skills that were building slowly to lead to Nemirovsky's magnum opus, *Suite Française*. However, it seems that greater attention went into crafting *Suite Française* for several reasons. A possible pitfall of this book is that it might not be long enough to allow the author to display all of her mastery. The novel centers on a poor Jew who converts to Catholicism after marrying a French wife, he becomes rich, and to cap it off, they plan a ball intended to display themselves as the "nouveau riche". His neurotic wife decides that her daughter will not attend, and in an act of vengeance, the teenager throws all the invitations into the Seine. She watches her mother's agony at not having any guests show up at the ball. I think that the story is a little exaggerated and over-the-top. Perhaps this was done to illustrate a point, but I am happy not to have met any family like the Kamfbs in my lifetime.
