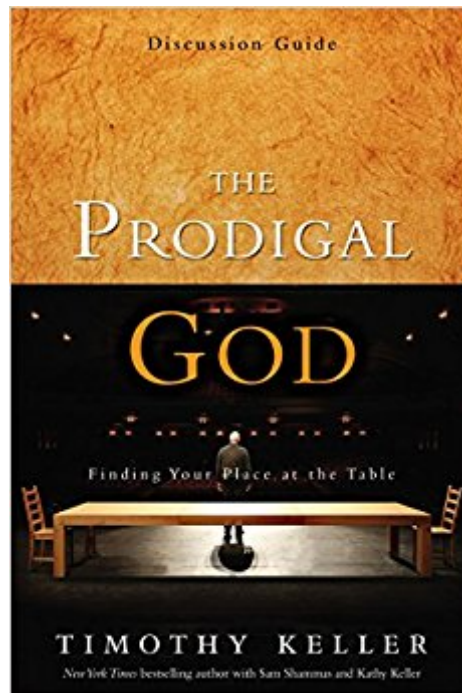




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The Prodigal God Discussion Guide: Finding Your Place At The Table

We didn't read the book along with the video sessions, but the questions provided in this discussion guide are fantastic for stimulating focused conversations. Our Biblestudy group is an interesting modge podge of people with different Christian backgrounds. One member had never been in an

open discussion based study, so questions like this encouraged her to look on her own at scripture in a new way. Another member is a new Christian and the open discussion atmosphere helped her feel emboldened by the Holy Spirit to contribute to conversation. My co-leader and I were more like conversation facilitators because the scripture and Keller's explanation is so straightforward. I found the videos on Vimeo for about \$20. We're a group of college aged girls, but I'd suggest this to any group of any age because the story of the younger and elder brothers is God's message to all his children.

Based on a couple of reviews I read on I almost decided not to use the study. I am so glad I did though! I have lead studies in group settings for 14 years now and this one has been one of the best. It's profound in content. Well organized. Really easy to lead with little to no prep work required and yet is not overly simplistic which is so often the case when something is easier to lead. The discussion that the study has generated in our group has been deep and thought provoking. I could not be more pleased. While the discussion guide is not essential for the study it's definitely been helpful and the appendices at the back on idols is useful. The guide made breaking up into smaller sub groups possible which I found to be beneficial to take things from the general to specific and making it personally applicable. I would consider Prodigal God one of my favorite books.Review of the DVD:If you're looking for 20 minute dvd sessions every week, this does not give you that. It is one 40 minute movie for the first session with 2 minute recap clips for the following sessions. At first i was a little nervous thinking that we will not fill up the hour and a half that we have with discussion...but we did! We could have almost done without the dvd clips we had so much discussion. Sometimes we went to 2 hours! It's more of a book based study than a dvd study. I would encourage everyone in the group

to get the Prodigal God book. I think only the leader needs the discussion booklet to pose questions to the group. I also used an easel for some charts that were in the discussion booklet. It all worked out really well.

Our church did this study and found it to be very beneficial. Hopefully, everyone knows that the videos that accompany the study are basically one main sermon on session 1 with six 3-4 minute reviews of the first session. This made our group a little hesitant at first because we mainly enjoy a good 20 minute video and then discussion but this discussion guide is good and has good questions if people keep up with the reading. I highly recommend it.

If you're seeking truth beyond the printed pages of scripture to this powerful parable, then I recommend you read this short, yet powerful, in depth study of the parable of the Prodigal Son. Inappropriately named, the Prodigal son, by tradition, it really speaks of the extravagant love and mercy of a loving, forgiving father. If you're not satisfied with traditional interpretations of, what I consider, the most powerful and profound parable taught by Jesus, then pick up this book as fast as you can. Keller takes you behind the scenes to study the Jewish traditions of what was happening behind the words of the youngest son's desire for his portion of the inheritance, and the extravagant, grace filled (Prodigal - true meaning), love of the father for his sons who were both "missing the mark". Tradition has taught far too long on the "sins" of the younger son, neglecting an even greater trespass of the older son. The book is also formatted for small group study, with a DVD presentation of Keller's teaching. This book changed the way my congregation views the Prodigal "GOD" parable. No more is it to be entitled the prodigal son parable, that is historically, biblically and by definition in gross error of the true meaning of this parable. Don't take my word for it, buy the book first and read it for yourself. I highly recommend it for your personal enlightenment and just possibly change your view of God forever.
