Robin Ooi writes clearly and definitively about what comprises a good SEO strategy and how to implement both everyday business practices and one-time marketing tactics to effect high SEO standards. As he states very well, Google is smart and changes the details of their ranking system often, so the best strategy for SEO is long-term and build on sensible, 101 business communication practices. But before you can do that you need to understand a few things about SEO, and "Your SEO Sucks" is a great guide to that. The basics are covered well, and then advanced info/strategy is included to help reader's understand how to position their site to suit Google, how to think like a buyer searching for your type of offering and how to research possible buyer's keywords. Robin describes a two-tier approach to link building, which is a strategy that takes time to build. "Your SEO Sucks" is not about flash-in-the-pan results. The strength in Your SEO Sucks is in the good advice regarding on-site optimization, and if you follow that and then slowly build backlinks, you'll be in business. Be aware that the book only focuses on Google, and does have a big emphasis on being knowledgeable about SEO and then hiring out for services as opposed to doing SEO yourself. Overall it's a great introduction to help you understand basic practices to craft your own strategy to prevail in the SEO wars.

I own a couple of websites/blogs and the strategies in this book were a great reminder and refresher of the best techniques in the SEO industry. The advice is actionable and free of spammy crap that you find in a lot of SEO books. The book even provides a chapter on how to hire a consultant if off-page SEO is not something that you want to deal with. If you are looking for a simple magic bullet SEO book, like use SEO Nuke to create 1000s of backlinks in an hour...this is not the book for you. If you want to learn about Google friendly SEO advice to drive more quality traffic to website, this is the book. I also enjoyed the use of heat maps in the book to identify where your highest quality content or call to actions should be placed.

This is a really helpful guide for those of us that could use a little help with our websites, blogs, and online businesses. It also helps the average individual stay relevant and informed on topics that may be too frustrating and technical otherwise. I found this guide to be a good refresher on the subject of SEO, and additionally, a more in-depth resource for other relevant content in one place so you don't have to spend hours wading through tons of other information online. The author is pretty straightforward and makes the info clear, concise, and pretty simple. If you are looking for a quick guide that will help you move forward with SEO and related topics, you may want to give this

book a try. Three stars because I wish it were a longer guide.

This is an outstanding book about search engine optimization (SEO). I love this book compared to other SEO titles, because it's actually written to be read by an average human. Other books I've purchased were so hard to understand. The Author of "Your SEO Sucks," Robin Ooi, uses vocabulary that every business owner can understand. One really cool graphic in this book is the Google heatmap, showing exactly where search engine traffic is focused on each Google search page. I also liked the graphics in each chapter to help outline many of the topics. The book answers several questions SEO beginners would have surrounding topics including: keywords, page rank, back links, and meta tags. There's a great example of keywords and an explanation and graphic regarding how long tail keywords are used by internet search. Ooi explains many of the "bread & butter" grouping and linking strategies for website optimization, and includes graphics for every example so you can visualize what's happening behind the scene. The book mainly focuses on Google, and doesn't do much besides mention Yahoo, Bing, and other search engines. Although, the Author explains that the majority of traffic comes from Google. I've started to apply these concepts in the book, and most seem very intuitive after I start doing them. From what I understand, SEO principles can change as Google makes updates to their search engine software, which could potentially make some of these tactics obsolete. All-in-all I think it's a great book, easy-to-read, and well worth the money for learning more about SEO.

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
