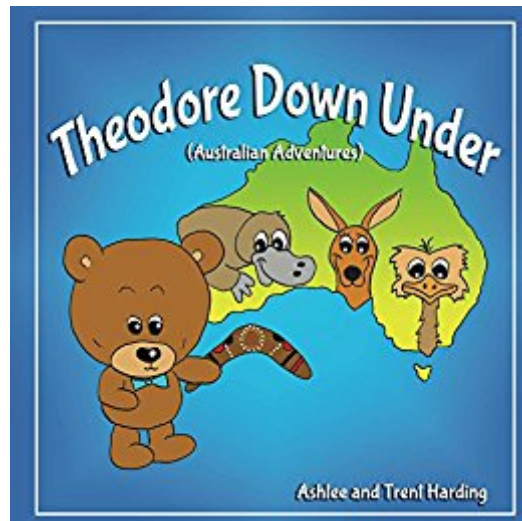

Australian sibling authors Trent and Ashlee Harding write and illustrate exciting, educational and valuable children's books with the desire to help youngsters with all aspects of literacy and numeracy. Both Trent and Ashlee are studying Occupational Therapy and Business at University. They live in Melbourne, Australia. The hero of the story is Theodore the bear and in this delightful book cum travelogue we are privy to the glories of Australia as Theodore is our guide. He shares the Great Barrier Reef (one of the 7 Wonders of the World), the Australian Outback where we see Uluru/Ayers Rock (one of the biggest rocks in the world), play with the boomerang, blowing into the

instrument known as the didgeridoo, the Sydney Opera House and the nearby Sydney Harbour Bridge, Bondi Beach, and from Theodore's cousin Bella we hear the wonderful Aussie slang that entertains us so often in movies. We are treated to an Aussie barbie (barbeque) with some of the foods served, some of the Aussies favorite animals – the koala and the kangaroo, the wombat and platypus and emu, and learn about the Australian's form of footy (football). Of course we also learn about the spiders and snakes, but they are quickly forgotten when the discussion extends to the vast amount of sheep in Australia. The pleasures of this book are many – and this travelogue/reference book about Australia will energize children's (and adults!) desire to visit this terrific country. Booking information, please! Traveling to Australia is on the top of my list so I like having a kids book about traveling there. My 3yr old fell in love with Theodore in a previous book so I have come to really enjoy the artistic style they use in the illustrations. It is difficult to hold my daughter's attention with the actual text though. In ebook form, it's a white page with text, then it is the matching illustration. She keeps swiping the screen to the picture before I even get halfway through the first sentence. I wish I had it in print so she could see the illustration while I read the words - or be able to put my device into landscape mode and have both pages come up (but I haven't seen an ebook pull that off well). The more I read Theodore books, the more my daughter enjoys it. It will be fun to see what stands out most in this book after several more readings. Will it be the different animals mentioned, the activities Theodore is doing, the phrases that the text teaches, or will she surprise me with something I didn't even notice until she points it out? Because she loves Theodore so much, I love these books. I can't stop recommending it to everyone with young kids.

This is a wonderful, child-friendly, and very informative story that is told with warmth and with lovely colorful drawings. Theodore looks cute. In the book, he tells us about his exciting flight to Australia,

the land with 24 million inhabitants and four times that number in sheep. This was his first flight ever and his first time in Australia. He tells us what he saw and experienced. He speaks about the Great Barrier Reef, one of the seven wonders of the world. Also the outback, about acquiring a boomerang there, about the didgeridoo, the Sydney Opera House, the famous Sydney Harbor Bridge, Bondi Beach, Aussie slang, such as mate means friend and rug up means dress warmly, and more. Children will enjoy learning about Australia, their unique slang, foods, games, play, and animals such as the Koala, Kangaroo, and others.

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
