

Set against the background of folklore myths and legends, Bird's Eye and Other Stories is a

collection of five uplifting and motivational stories for kids five years and older. In fact, the strong moral content of the book qualifies it as a great reading material for any age group. Author D. R. Tara scores again with this, the sixth in the series of 'Illustrated Moral Stories for Children'. Complete with colorful pictures for every story, this children's fiction graphically illustrates each moral and theme with clearly written stories that are easy to understand and follow. Themes such as 'success comes when we keep our eyes focused on our goal', 'the priceless nature of true love and friendship', 'friendship knows no barrier', 'anger never wins' and 'the value of forgiveness' are well developed and presented in such a simple yet profound way that they speak volumes to all personalities. The length of the stories is short, which makes it well suited for bedtime. Children can fall asleep having learned a valuable life lesson; and the good thing is, these lessons can be re-enforced over and over again. As the sage, Perry told his wife, "Though he has done us great harm, I still love him. He acted in rage because he has not found God" What Divine Forgiveness! And what a lesson to pass on to kids! This book is worth the reading.

D.R. Tara's book for children, 'Bird's Eye and other Stories' is one of the best bedtime story books for kids by all ages I've seen in months. Even at the get-go, you'll see it has everything young readers love to find in their kids illustrated books: colourful illustrations, exciting stories, and a moral lesson that neatly wraps it up in one powerful, life-shaping emotional impact. The 'Bird's Eye and other Stories' consists of five tales, each of which focuses on one important nugget of wisdom: 'Bird's Eye', for example, is about focusing on your target and not allowing room for distraction or discouragement, while 'Anger Makes One Weak' is a compelling fleshing out of the vicissitudes of nurturing anger in your heart, and what you must do to get rid yourself of it. As mentioned, the five stories are carefully written in a way that even the youngest reader (actually, you will want to read this book to your children in order to explain certain complex concepts to them) will understand them. What's more, this is only the sixth in D.R. Tara's series of children's picture books for kindle - there's a lot more where this comes from. So get a copy of the previous five books, too (you can find them by clicking on the author's name). Overall, this is an exceptional book for kids. If you're looking something that will entertain and teach kids about life-affirming values, get a copy of this and also get the previous five books. Highly recommended to every parent out there. It seems the author took care to relate to a variety of cultures in this book.
