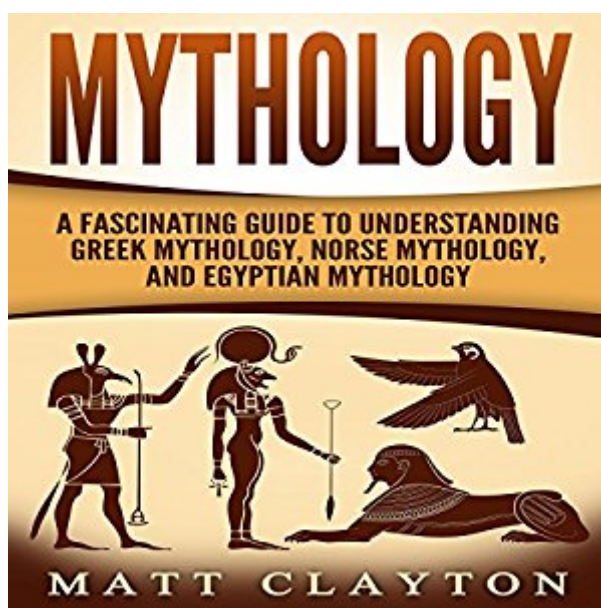

I have been fascinated with Greek Mythology from the time I was a 6-7 years old and have read all the mythological legends including the Homer classics in my own native language before embarking on reading the English translations when I had access to a library! Hence, I was familiar with the stories but it was totally absorbing to read the linked history. It made these stories even more appealing!! Wow! It brought out all their all too human qualities and failings in all their totality. The same applies to the Norse mythology. I knew some of the legends connected with Valkyries, Valhalla, Odin and Thor to mention a few, but this part added enormous and hitherto unknown to me facts to my limited

knowledge and rendered my awareness even more comprehensive. I love the way this part is covered in different sections covering different geographical areas including the Norman invasion of Britain! Egyptian mythology included areas starting from the Nile Valley to Mesopotamia in the current Iraq!! The gods and goddesses of ancient Egypt were dealt with in an extensive manner beginning with Ra, Osiris, Isis, Set and Horus along with all the stories and legends associated with them along with all the correlated stories.
