

He proves what Luke intended for Acts to be interpreted not as the apostles' glorious acts, but as the life-changing acts of the Holy Spirit. The same Spirit lives in believers today, the same God calls followers to expand His church, and the same basic problems still arise within the church, but the same power available then is still available now to change the nations.

For ten years he was associated with the Back to the Bible radio broadcast, first as Bible teacher and then as general director. Dr. Wiersbe has written more than 160 books, including the popular "BE" series of Bible commentaries, which has sold more than four million copies. He and his wife, Betty, live in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Wiersbe is probably one of my favorite writers. This book was so insightful and meaningful. It digs deep and draws out treasures from God's word like I've never experienced before. Amazing and highly recommended to those seeking our wanting a deeper relationship with God.
