

Only minor alterations to spelling, punctuation and proof texts have been made by the editors of this Pocket Puritan gift edition. This little volume is not issued as an authoritative rule, or code of faith, whereby you are to be fettered, but as an assistance to you in controversy, a confirmation in faith, and a means of edification in righteousness.' As a confessional Reformed Baptist pastor I own about 4 different editions of this confession, but this has become my very favorite. The handy size and the soft leather binding are a fitting tribute to this time tested and proven confession of the faith once for all delivered to the saints!

Great for carrying to work, taking on trips, and etc. This was the Baptist Confession of Faith used by "The Prince of Preachers", Charles Haddon Spurgeon, and makes for a great devotional work along with Spurgeon's "Morning and Evening". For those who want "Keach's" Baptist Catechism also, Solid Ground Books publishes the Baptist Catechism and this Confession of Faith together. This is

the Second London Baptist Confession of Faith. Some sources report it was available privately in 1677. It is based on the Westminster Confession of Faith (1646) and the Savoy Declaration. Banner of Truth also offers the Westminster Confession in its Pocket Puritan Series. Every Baptist who believes in the doctrines of grace, as well as those want to learn what Strict and Particular Baptists believed then and now would find this edition useful in their studies.
