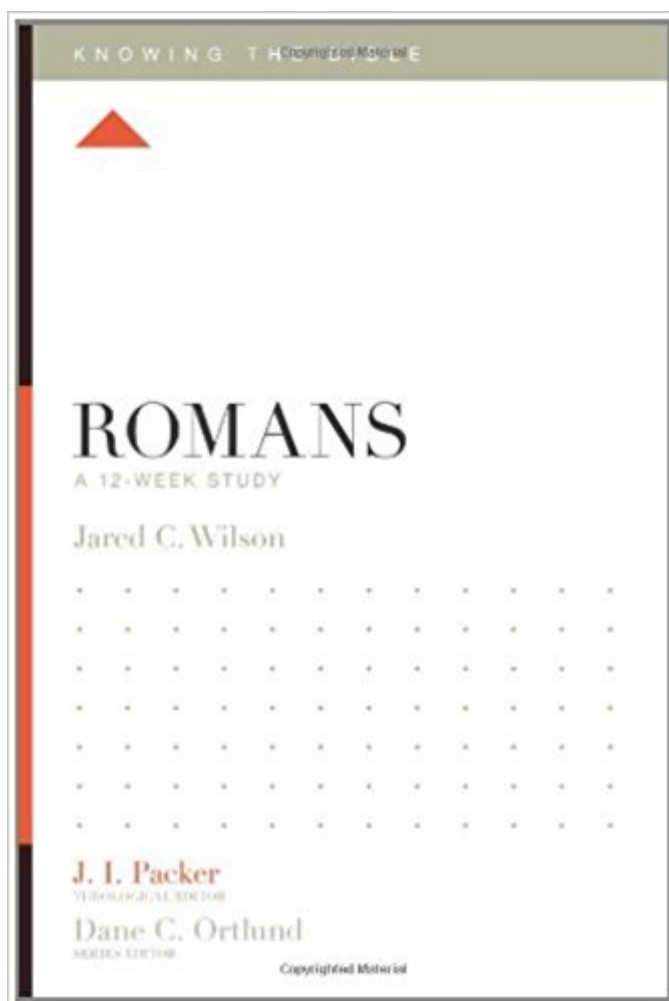

These Knowing the Bible volumes introduce a significant and very welcome variation on the general run of inductive Bible studies. This study guide on Romans has some excellent aspects and some very poor aspects; hence 3 stars. The excellent parts of the guide are the explanatory paragraphs at the end of each chapter called the Gospel Glimpses, Whole-Bible Connections, and Theological Soundings. These paragraphs explain clearly and briefly the important teachings in each portion of Scripture. The very poor parts of the study are the questions in each lesson. As the leader of the study group, I was very disappointed that most of the questions totally omitted the critically important doctrines and teachings in Romans. So if you choose this study guide on Romans, be prepared to write your own questions or heavily supplement the questions in the guide.
