

You can just tell it's one of those situations where they are both fighting their attraction (definitely on Bronagh's part). Dominic is possessive (even way before they

get together), protective, can be a prick, and sexy as all get out. Bronagh has spent the last 9 years of her life shutting everyone out except for her sister. He really gets her to come out of her shell and let people in. I absolutely loved the dynamic between them as well as the relationships she develops with his brothers. All of the characters had very unique personalities and I loved getting to know them. This book flowed really well. It felt like everything naturally progressed and it wasn't forced.
