

William Shakespeare (1564-1616) wrote 37 plays. King Lear and Macbeth are widely considered his finest and most popular. They are, perhaps, the most frequently produced works on the planet.

What a difference there is between listening to these two works! In VENUS AND ADONIS, David Burkes narration smoothly bridges dramatized sections. However, Clare Corbetts Venus and Benjamin Soamess Adonis are difficult to follow despite the rolling majesty of their deliveries. Both narrators know how to deliver verse, but their emotional tone is oratorical, inflated throughout, so few emotional distinctions are communicated. By contrast, David Burkes narrative presence in THE RAPE OF LUCRECE is just as smooth, and Eve Bests Lucrece solidly brings the characters emotional torture to life. The verse is just as lofty, and the emotional range of the cast is much
