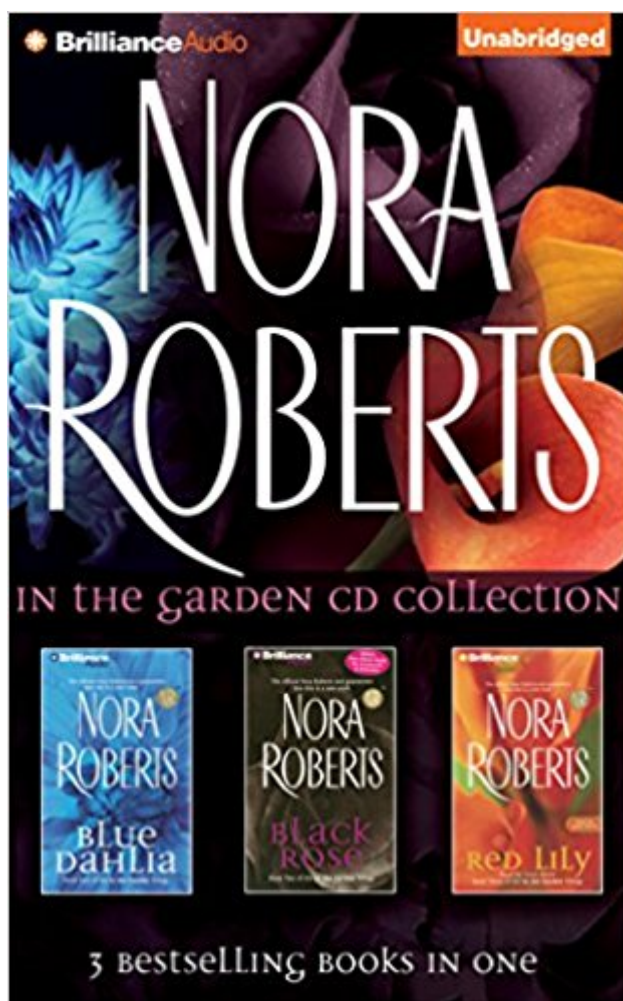

I love this author but since I have had this iPad these seven months and re-read these books one thing is starting to bug me. There are too many pages dedicated to overly involved sex scenes. When I first started reading her books if I remember correctly there was hardly any sexual details. Now they are so graphic and sometimes unnecessary to the story line I find myself skipping ahead. I am no prude but a great writer doesn't have to resort to this type of thing to make a good read. I have read books by authors written in the thirties, forties and fifties that hinted at what was going on but had no need to gratuitously get so graphic. I found them much better reading than what this has become and this author isn't the only one I have read for years to start writing this so unnecessarily. For the most part I love Ms. Roberts books, but I do wish she would reign in this particular way of writing.

I love Nora Roberts. I hated to answer the "how would you describe" questions that gave you a choice of answers that didn't necessarily apply. Her books always have well developed characters, a dollop of the supernatural and the topic of this book - gardening and the lives of a group of gardeners (who, for the record, are far from boring) and a resident ghost who likes to stir up trouble and who lives in the beautiful old mansion that belongs to one of the main characters. While some of Nora's books are perhaps a bit faster paced than these, that doesn't mean you aren't in for the usual interesting twists and turns and a unique story line. If you like Nora Roberts you'll like these books, if you like to garden, you'll like them even more, if you don't like to garden, no worries, there's plenty of romance and other things to keep your interest. I don't know how Nora Roberts manages to come up with so many books each with a unique set of circumstances and unique characters.

Typical Nora Roberts trilogy format--the women characters are well delineated and interesting, particularly the middle aged founder of In the Garden, the men characters less well explored (which is typical of romance books)--although I liked the middle aged love interest for Ros very much--a refreshing change from the standard 20-30 something men in this genre. The gardening motif is a nice frame for the series giving a beautiful and complex background for the plot and action. I enjoyed the first two in the series the most, by the time Red Lily came around it seemed a bit worn

out, everything relevant about the main characters had already been delineated and the love story between the principals was a bit hackneyed. The angry psychotic ghost pushed the plot along through the first two books and we finally find out what sent her around the bend and what caused her to haunt Harper House, but by that time you really couldn't care much about it because she was a truly unlovable down and dirty person in life, so why care much about her ghost other than laying it? As I said, my overall assessment is that the first two books in the series are much stronger and more enjoyable than the third, but as a loyal reader I kept going just to see how it turned out.

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
