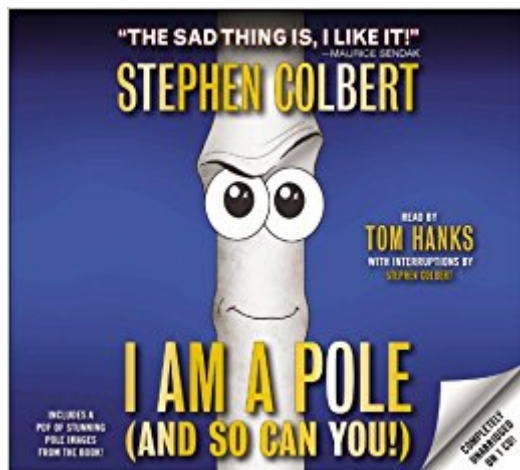

The cover and title mimicks Colberts' first book, I am America (And so can you!), the story is a bit longer than on the interview, and the illustration is truely great. I purchased the hardcover and audiobook, and they are worth every single penny.

I love Stephen Colbert. Thus is an amazing kids book. My one and five year olds love me reading this book to them.

Just like the late great Maurice Sendak (author of many classic children's books such as Where The Wild Things Are) says in his blurb on the cover "The sad thing is I like it!"
