

People who are interested in apocalypticism in Christianity will find this book very informative. The Enochian literature was widely read in the second temple period and often referred to by Christians in the second and third century. The Jews rejected it by the late first century and it lost favor with most Christians within a few hundred years. It lasted the longest in Egypt where gnosticism and mysticism retained its popularity for five or six hundred years longer. There is a chapter about the influence and transmission of 4, 5 and 6 Ezra. It seemed a bit tedious to me because I'm not so interested in the source of documents. The most interesting part of the book for me was chapter 5, which is about the interpretation of Daniel 9 in the early church. It was worth the price of the book.

When evidence comes to light that maybe we don't know EVERYTHING about the gospels scholars, like attack dogs they tear apart, discredit, or out and out LIE to the public to keep there dogma. This book happens to be a very in-depth source of information. it wasn't the easiest read unless you are a theology major some passages do not make sense to the layperson.
