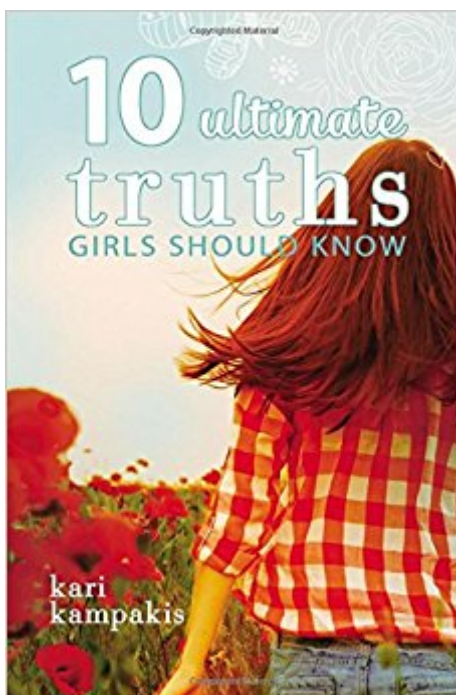

Gr 7-10 "Aware that adolescence can be an overwhelming time for girls, Kampakis has created a version of the 10 commandments for teens. She lays out her ultimate truths ("Kindness is more important than popularity"; "You were born to fly"), covering a different one in each chapter ("Confidence," "Reputation," "Patience," "Inner Beauty"). Written from a conservative Christian

perspective, the text supplies biblical references to support each truth. Kampakis discusses why each of these topics is an important part of being a girl and how complete acceptance of God's plan is the best path to future happiness. The advice is reassuring and encouraging and the writing accessible, but the book only addresses Christian readers. The chapters on interacting with boys promote "The Rules"-like dating behavior ("If you want a boy to court you, don't make it too easy. Let him work a little"), but it's a standard message in conservative circles. I am so thankful for what this book has allowed me to do with some small groups and know I will reference it for years to come for my own children. I think this is a great book for anyone that has any interaction with girls to read, especially Daddy's. Its hard and 10 Ultimate Truths is a great glimpse into some of the common things our girls will go through and for women its a great reminder of where we've been. I have so many favorite parts of the book, I tried to think of my most favorite and three more popped out at me. Read it, you will love it.

This book was outstanding! I gave it to my admittedly mature-for-her-age 11-year-old for her birthday. She blew through it in four days. She thoroughly enjoyed the book and as I pressed her for the things that stood out to her, I realized she was getting from the text exactly the things I hoped to hear her say about not bowing to peer pressure, about being kind to other girls, about only having one chance to make a first impression, about how to present herself around and interact with boys. These are things we're teaching her as her parents, but it's great to have another voice echo ours to reinforce what we're saying. I read it along with her on my Kindle so I had context for what she was telling me and the subsequent conversations were so precious. It was a great resource with which we were able to engage these issues together and start building the foundation for when the teenage years begin in earnest.

GREAT BOOK! My 11 year old daughter said it gave her new perspective on a lot of things she hadn't thought of. I think it's something so important that I'm going to use it to lead a "home group" for my church and read it as a group for 12 year old girls.

The book contains thought-provoking questions, which are a great opportunity to talk with your kids and turn it into a teachable moment. It would be great for a Girl Scout troop or small group discussion in Sunday School. The 10 areas are popularity, confidence, reputation, interacting with boys, self-worship, perseverance, patience, image, inner beauty, and self-talk. It's written in a friendly, conversational style (not dissimilar from Beth Moore's style) and has discussion questions, relevant scripture, and fun quizzes to see where the teens are in terms of responding in a healthy way to some situations. I cannot recommend this book enough. The 10 truths are spot on with what

we need to ingrain in our girls, even before they are 'tested' in the Junior High and High School years. I received this book free from Thomas Nelson part of the Book Look review bloggers program, for my honest and un-biased opinion.
