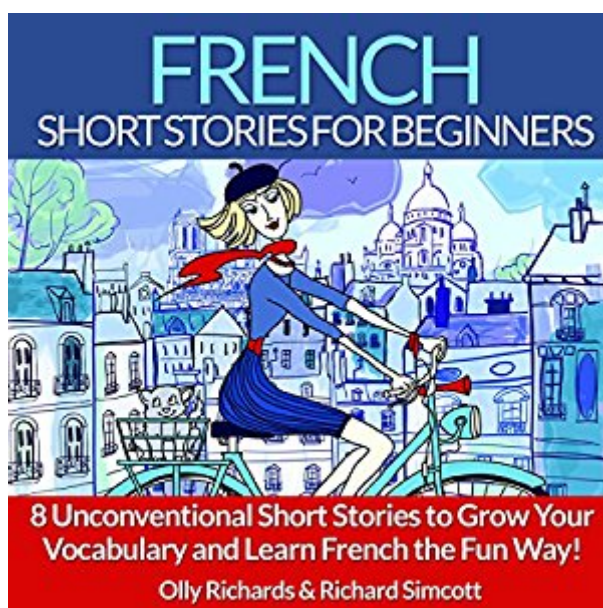

If you understand French at about A2 level, this will give you a great boost. On its own, it's not bad, but paired with the audiobook (available via Audible), you have a cheap source of comprehensible input.

I really enjoyed this book and what is more important, it helped me with my French. What the author said was true. Short stories which keep your interest and the questions at the end let you know how much you actually understood. I would recommend it.

This is the second short stories for beginners book I have read and i like this format for learning. I am encouraged by my progress.

My French skills seem to be forever basic to intermediate, but one thing that helps me quite a bit is reading at or slightly above my level. These stories are engaging and very readable, yet are using vocabulary that is perfect for learners. I get frustrated reading children's books, because how often will I use the words for dragons or alligators in conversation? I'm so impressed with how Richards and Simcott seem to zero in on the most useful vocabulary I need to learn and pack it into a story that is still fun to read. Well worth it!

I have to say that the most surprising part but very useful was the beginning of the book - How to use the book and how to read these stories. Olly and Richard encourage you to read it without a dictionary first. I also loved that the book uses different tenses. Imparfait and Passé Composé for example. The stories are engaging, not too long, not too short, not too difficult to follow. I also

liked the questions after each chapter. The summary is a great idea also. You can check if you understood the gist of the story well and if not, you will not get lost in the story. I think the authors did a great job.

So far I've only completed one out of the 8 short stories included. I'll update my review if anything changes. I love the book because it's easy to learn the words as they are used in context. The stories contain a lot of dialogue between characters so the reader gets an idea of how informal conversational French is spoken. Also, the directions for how to read the stories and learn the new vocabulary are excellent!

Despite what the title may say, this is no ordinary book. I've been following Olly for awhile and seeing his endeavors in writing short stories, and I finally decided to get a copy for myself. The authors Olly Richards and Richard Simcott are professional language learners and are all too familiar with the feeling of encountering new vocabulary and fumbling their way through reading a passage. This book isn't a "look at my writing skills" demonstration as one can easily assume from the title. I was also personally skeptical at one point, but after reading I've had my assumptions debunked. It is a work tailored to one who wants to deeper enhance their linguistic and cultural knowledge, complete with short excerpts concerning "how to read effectively" and a 6 step reading process so you have a guideline to constructively read rather than skim and hope for the best. This is further helped by key terms and words being bolded to for your eyes to catch. Even though they are real stories and not one page child fairytales, you are assured by the authors to remember that this isn't a race. You aren't supposed to understand everything first glance. At the end of each chapter a short summary is given, with the key vocab as well meaning you don't need to stress if you didn't write everything down! There are even multiple choice questions to further test your comprehension. The stories are split into chapters in a bite size amount so that you can digest but also follow the characters instead of switching to a new short story every time you turn the page. As mentioned above because these guys are professional language learners, you are in good hands. You are getting an absolute steal for all the vocabulary given inside. Not just book vocabulary, but very real everyday vocabulary you WILL use in a French speaking country. Enjoy reading and I hope it helps!

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
