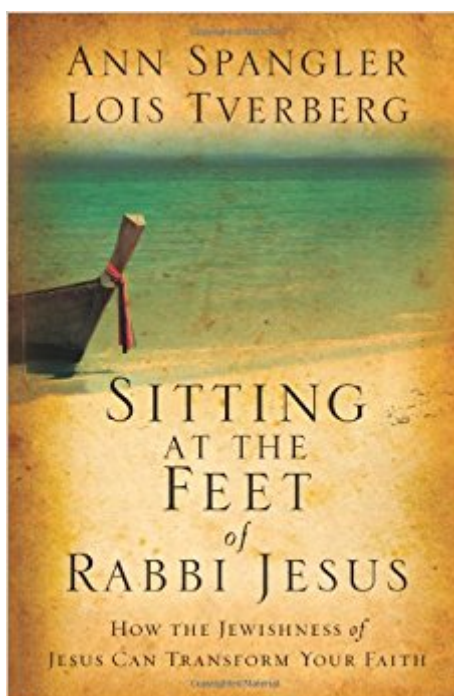


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Sitting At The Feet Of Rabbi Jesus: How The Jewishness Of Jesus Can Transform Your Faith

They seemed kind of patched together in an almost "stream-of-consciousness" way.
