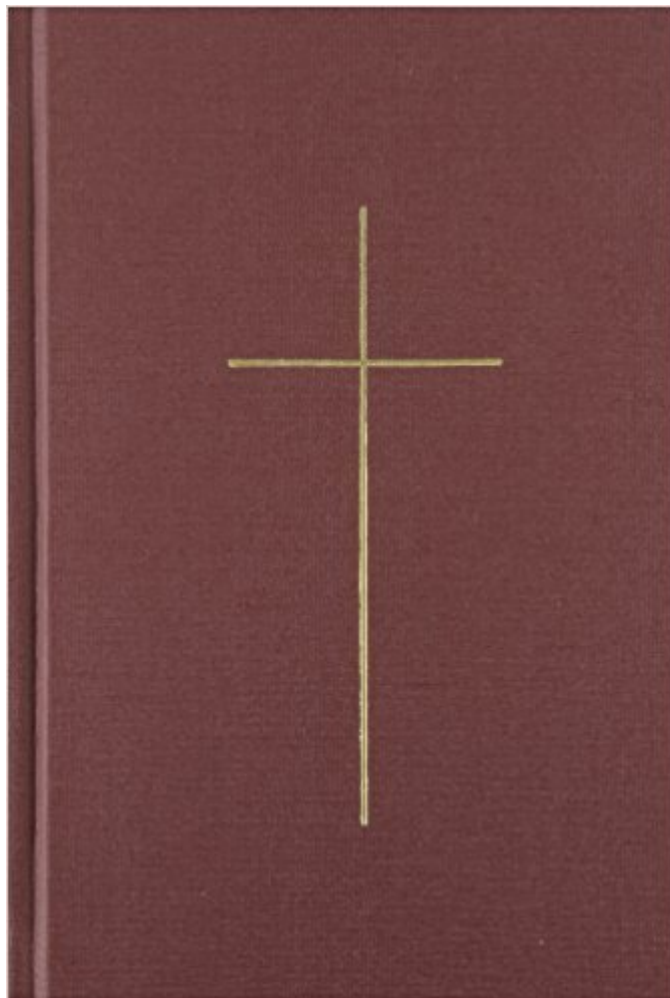

While the pages are photocopied (as noted on the opening pages) they are very clear and do not look photocopied in any way. The gilt edge paper is high quality, very nice. I'm not Episcopalian, but I love this book and the gentle prayers to read. Look forward to many years of reading!

This is a personal edition of the 1928 BCP. It has two yellow ribbons for marking pages and travels well. However, you need to be careful with the ribbons when it comes to turning pages. The pages are pretty thin and I've managed to tear a couple (just a little) with the ribbon inadvertently. We got these as gifts for confirmations. The presented to page in the front is perfect for this.
