

While there are some really good points made in this book, I would caution a spiritually young Christian from reading. I know Christians need to be careful about over emphasizing grace to the

extent that people are not repentant for their sins - but Bevere seems to take an almost condemning approach. Issues of sovereign rule and submission to authority seem out of balance. Scripture is used but at times seems out of context. God is good - there is NO evil in Him. He uses and works with the fallen and evil to bring good forth. He is not the author of evil.

Excellent book. Very well written. Every pastor or church leaders should read this book. Especially those who desire God's blessing on their life and ministry.

This is an incredible teaching that I wish I would have had twenty years ago! Every Christian at some point in your walk needs this if you want to have a truly intimate and personal walk with our Lord (in my humble opinion). Any reviews saying this teaching is harmful are speaking from wounds most likely from authority abuse. I pray that you go to Jesus for complete healing for all of your wounds. He's come that we may have life and have it more abundantly! Let the thief steal no more and walk in a freedom you have never known. I'm sorry if I'm coming across preachy but this has changed my marriage, how I view and pray for government officials (especially the ones I don't agree with), and I'm walking in freedom that has me super excited to get up every day and serve my God. When I first read this book I liked it more than I do now. It is easy to get sucked into a teaching or doctrine when you only hear one side and don't give time to the Holy Spirit to process. I like most of the books I have read by John Bevere, but this one I cannot swallow. In my opinion it is teachings such as this one that keeps the church stifled and stuck in an old wineskin. The old is always better to those in old wineskins and are resistant to change. When we are stuck under the 'covering' of the old then the church is doomed to an indefinite existence of stagnation. I do agree that God sets up leaders in the church and younger members should have an attitude of respect and even obedience. But this only goes so far. God never intended his leaders to be controlling (He is not even controlling Himself, and He is God) and He certainly did not expect his followers to blindly follow other men just because they are in leadership positions. Jesus told us to follow Him, and also, 'the head of every man is Christ'. I think John went a little too far with his covering teaching and I consider it to be a doctrine with a big red flag.

I recommend it to all those looking to know the Holy Spirit and those interested in more depth with the Word of God
