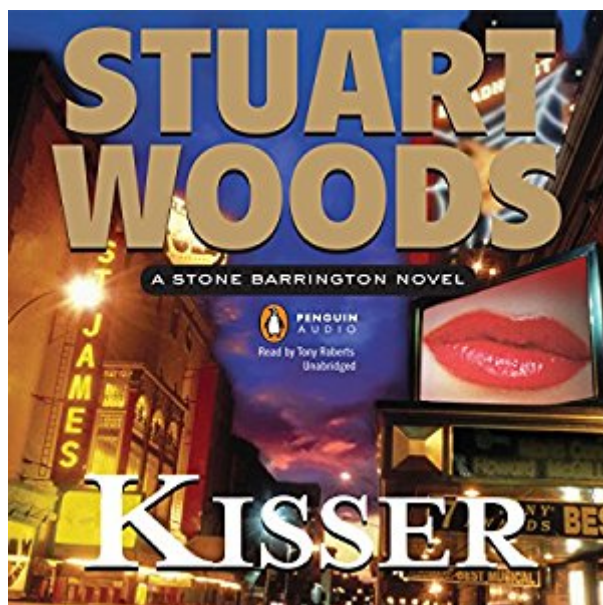

They're great for escapism, and they're page-turners, but there's really nothing that you haven't seen many times in his stories: everyone succeeds well at what they do, every character has either a trust fund, a divorce settlement, or a huge inheritance. No one lacks for money or means, and Barrington has no trouble getting laid. But if you enjoyed one of these books, you will enjoy all of them.

thin story, shallow events, illogical activities

I've been reading Woods for a long time now, and as each passing work is published, he delves deeper and deeper into what I can only describe as male romance novels. If you read this, then Chiefs, you will not believe they have emerged from the same brain. I don't buy Woods novels to be intellectually stimulated, but I also don't buy them for a pandering. All of his characters have become cartoons of their former selves. I can't believe he still makes a reference to Delano, GA in every work. At this point, I think he would be embarrassed for people to know there was a link to a once great literary town, in a once meaningful literary world. This was my last Woods buy.

Whenever the plot wasn't moving, he throws in a sex scene. Now I enjoy a good sex scene as much as the next reader; but after a while, they seemed like a mannerism. Remove them and the rest of the book isn't very interesting. I was disappointed, since I've liked most of what he's written earlier.
