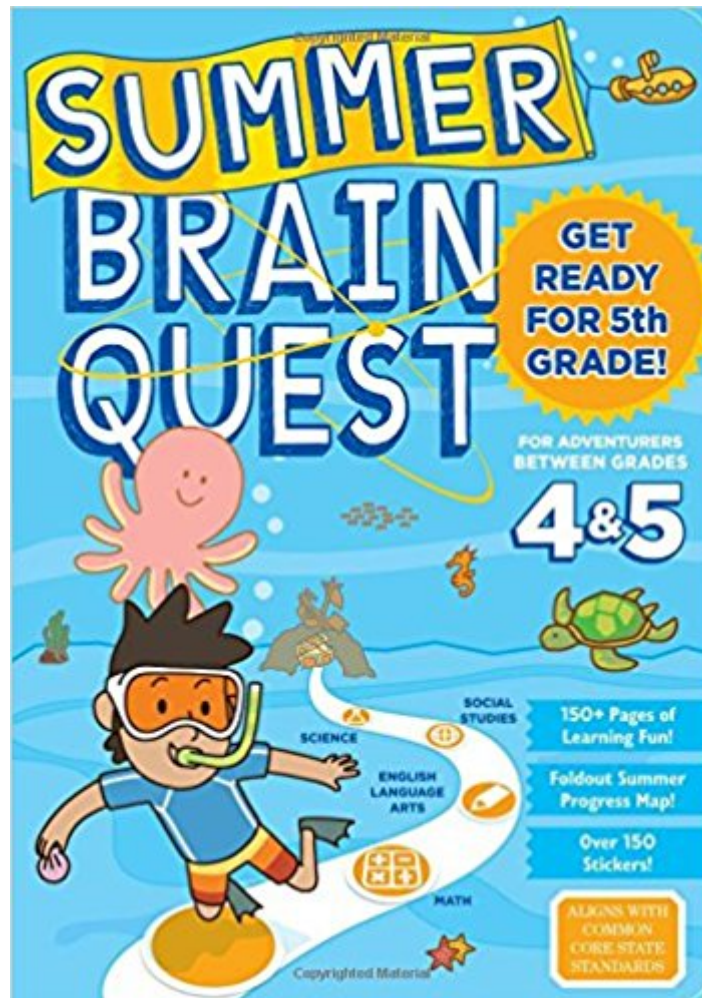

My kid really did fall for the whole "complete the map" idea at the end of the book. It is a bit challenging for her (she is between 2nd and 3rd grade), but work is presented in a way that incrementally builds up concepts. So, I needed to show her something about multiplication at the first chapter, but she hasn't asked for any help since. It looks like it has mixed subjects that each increase in difficulty as you work your way through in order - which is different from the other BrainQuest books. Because this is heavy paper, the book is too heavy to bring on airplane trips and because of the stickers and maps, you don't want to tear the pages out. So, in summary, my only 'complaint' is that this is too nice of a product to use piecemeal.

My son has always been above his "pay grade". I am using this to reinforce but also to challenge. We both like that it is full color and engaging. The readings are short but interesting. They are good conversation starters. so far so good, but Brain Quest has not failed me yet.

didn't realize it aligned with common core standards because I was trying to find workbooks this summer which weren't on common core curriculum (our kids are in private school.) but otherwise good material, i had my kids skip some of the math ones that they weren't used to the processes of doing, or had them just write out the answers and ignore the instruction. -copying and pasting this review on the other grades i bought for the other summer brain quest i purchased-

The book doesn't have a steady flow from one grade to the next. It all seems like it's just mixed up together in one. I was expecting something going from 4th grade level and morphing into harder work and that's just not the case. For the subjects to be color coded and because I used to use their long question and answer cards when I was little, I expected much more organization to be at hand. We got through the the book pretty okay, but I was just disappointed at how confusing the set up was. Removed two stars because of that. Even though my son finished the book, I wouldn't recommend and I would not buy again.

These are cute & not too difficult lessons, just to keep my daughter going so homework isn't such an adjustment when school starts. There are A & B options for most of the sections, so your child can "complete" the book without having to do every page. I like that math and reading lessons are all interspersed, for kids (like mine) who enjoy one over the other, it's not days and days to get through those pages they dislike. This book lost a star because the pages keep falling out, and not at the perforation, at the binding. I gave up taping them back in. But even the sticker pages, to mark her progress, fell out. It's now a bookmark.

We love these summer quest books! They make learning during the summer fun! There are outdoor challenges that feel like fun adventures and the learning is on par, not too easy but not too hard. With cute themes, stickers, maps and extras, I'd surely purchase more Brain Quest education materials.

This is way too easy for a 4th grader going into 5th. The reading level is 2nd to 3rd grade at best and some of the math is too simple. There are a few fractions, but nothing challenging or thought provoking.
