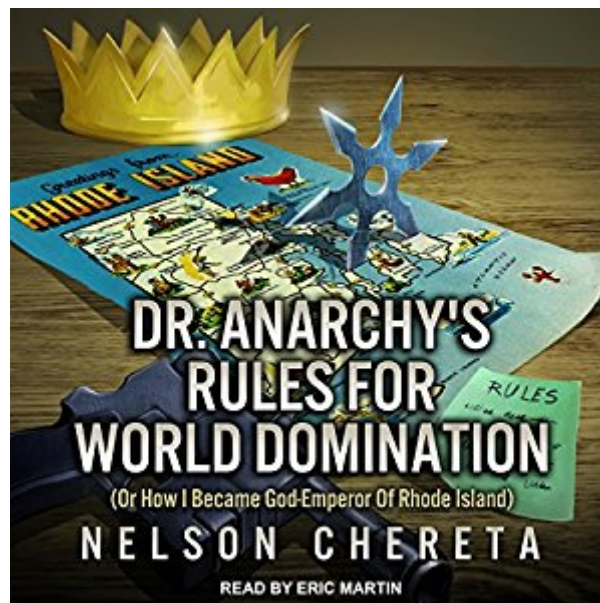

Another fun book from this author. In a land where superpowers exist the author chose his protagonist to be merely "one of the smartest" people in the world. This was a great choice since this was another character that had to outsmart rather than overpower his enemies - and many times he couldn't outsmart them either. He wasn't a hero or anti-hero, just a guy with a big chip on his shoulder but in the end had just enough self awareness to avoid major disasters. I was disappointed this book came before book 3 of the rabbit series, but in the end it was a pleasant distraction.
