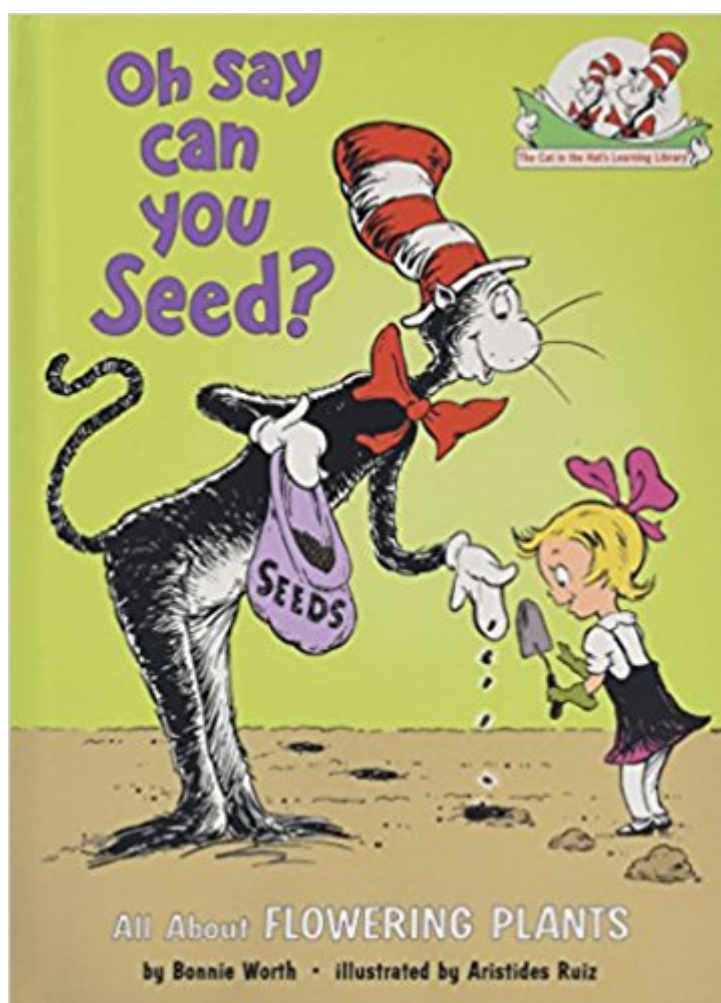

Our grandkids love these Cat in the Hat Learning Library books. They've become favorites for both our 21/2 and 5 year old. The rhyming sentences impart lots of new information for kids in a delightful way.

I read this to my first grade class when we were learning about seeds and the plant lifecycle. It has a great book. It is very informative and covered everything we were learning in great detail. If anything, it went into too much detail, so I skimmed over some of the text because of short attention spans. This would be great for 2-4th graders. It is a science text, it is not the typical Dr. Seuss book.

This book was a great way to teach my students about plant life cycles. I teach 5th grade and this book was perfect for them to understand. Even 5th grade students are still fascinated with how Dr Seuss books keep the rhyme up so well throughout. It actually covers the topic in a scientific and entertaining way.

Although my two daughters are a bit too young to understand the more scientific side of this book, there are plenty of ways to explain it in a way that toddlers can somewhat understand and have a basic knowledge of seeds and gardens etc. I have never been so impressed with the vibrant, fun, and detailed illustrations in any Dr. Seuss book. Every page was colorful and beautiful really. I look forward to watching my 2 and nearly 3 year old grow up with books like this one that they will slowly

but surely acquire more knowledge from.
