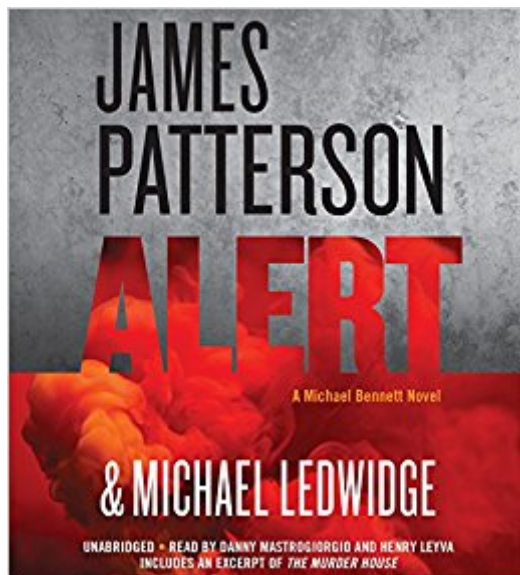

James Patterson has had more New York Times bestsellers than any other writer, ever, according to Guinness World Records. Since his first novel won the Edgar Award in 1977 James Patterson's books have sold more than 300 million copies. He is the author of the Alex Cross novels, the most popular detective series of the past twenty-five years, including Kiss the Girls and Along Came a Spider. He writes full-time and lives in Florida with his family.

Bennett is a good father, son, and detective. The timing is finally right for Michael and MC, but that damn Emily keeps popping up at the most unopportunistic times. I wish she wouldn't come back or

maybe be killed. The main plot involves a genius who is terrorizing NYC by all possible and seemingly impossible means, going so far as to kill and destroy the people and the city. Det. Bennett turned all of his underlings at that pathetic ombudsmen unit in the hood into good policemen and policewomen. He also still works with the major crimes unit on an as needed basis at One Police Plaza. This book had everything to make it the best in this series, but I didn't give it a five star rating because of Emily. She just doesn't fit with Michael's Catholic beliefs like MC does.

Another great action-filled book at a pretty quick pace by James Patterson. Good story and some romance stirring with Catherine while in Ireland. New York is a great place to visit with many things to offer, so why are they trying to destroy it? Hints at terrorists from Iraq, al Qaeda, homegrown emigrant jihadists, another Unabomber. Bombs and technology hired out to American young geeks and college students with the latest technology training and skills...the threat of the future now present. A fantastic and up-to-the-minute possibility waiting to happen. There is a message of vigilance and alarm in the book for security interested people everywhere. But for me today, it was a real page turner and I hope Hollywood makes a movie soon!

I'm almost sorry I enjoyed this book. I've given up on Patterson, except for his efforts with a few of his "minions", and this is one of them. While it does draw you in, if you stop to think you'll realize the plot is a little far-fetched and the villains even more far-fetched. Still, decent "beach reading".

Patterson's writing factory has churned out another formulaic treatment of a terrorist plot. While his characters are interesting, this book requires a little too much suspension of disbelief. I've read better from the factory, and I suspect I will again in the future.

A man, who turns out to be a Russian mob boss, and his son who is genius attempt to blow up New York by first blowing up a tunnel of the subway system. Then they shoot and kill the mayor of New York as he is trying to calm the people. Detective Bennett is lead investigator and tracks information that leads him to the suspects as they plan for another catastrophe to happen.
