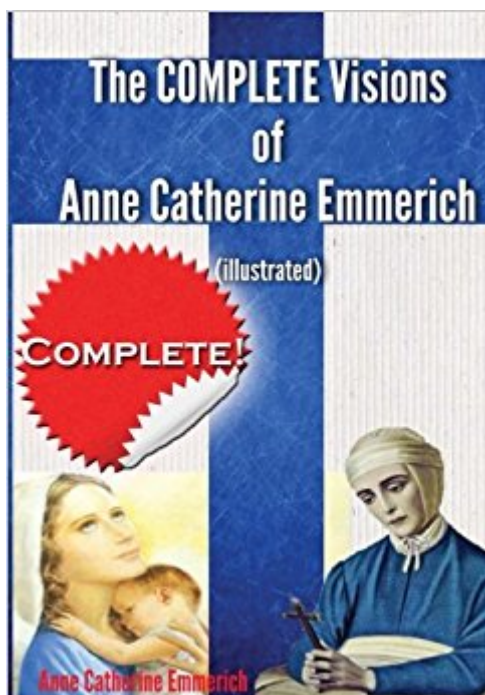

Anne Catherine Emmerich was born to poor parents at Westphalia, Germany in 1774. When she was twenty-eight years old she became an Augustinian nun at ulmen, and apparently began to experience ecstasies as a result of spiritual favors. She received the Stigmata in 1813, confined to her bed, and reportedly convinced a vicar-general, Overberg, and three physicians of her sanctity. She later reported that she had seen visions of Christ and the souls in purgatory as a child, as well as a circular core with three sections representing the Trinity. She is the author of The Dolorous Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ, The Life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Life of Jesus Christ and Biblical Revelations, and The Bitter Passion and the Life of Mary.

Wow! So interesting to read! One of the things I have always hoped for when I get to heaven is that God has a "photo gallery" or "film" so we can see how all of history really looked. What did the Garden of Eden look like? And Noah's Ark? And the Tower of Babel? Anne's gift of spiritual visions

allowed her to automatically "see" these things as she heard the stories. As a little girl, she assumed everyone else could see these things as clearly as she did, but then she learned that is not the case. Her visions add so much depth and shed light on many points of sacred scripture. A lot of wonderful things to meditate on, and a lot of new perspective to help teachings "sink in."

This is of great spiritual value to me. The imagery helps me see the Biblical "characters" as the real people they are. I am going to start reading it again as i'm sure I'll get more out of it with each reading. I will say the footnotes in the Kindle version are horribly done. They interrupt the story even coming up in the middle of sentences. It would be better to read the paper version. I so know this is not truly the "complete" visions of Sister Emmerich. The story ends quite abruptly. There was much more to her meditations including into more recent centuries.

Excellent private revelations! Eye opening details; fills in the blanks of some scriptural stories without in any way effecting the substance and message of the Bible. As an example, until I read these revelations, I never understood why, when Isaac blessed Jacob instead of Esau, he couldn't just take it back and give it to Esau as he originally intended. The "blessing" wasn't just words, and

when Isaac passed it on, he couldn't take it back. This "blessing" had been passed down from the time of Adam, from whom it was withdrawn, but later returned to humanity and passed down through Noah and his eldest son, Shem. A great read!

If you are interested in what may have happened in Jesus' life during the times left out of the Gospels then this is a good resource. It is hard to believe that this could all be simply an act of imagination, however, that is left to each individual to reckon with. There are so many references to towns and villages, events and people that would be impossible to glean from historical records alone. It is surely inspired from a woman whose spirit is deeply in communion with her faith in God. It is a rich, detailed and beautiful look at the times in which the Holy Family lived. A rare and wonderful book that will enrich the life of any Christian.

I have heard about Blessed Anne Catherine Emmerich's end times visions...which are not included in this book. I thought the words "COMPLETE Visions" would include them also. It is, however, filled with the most intimate details about the life and times of Jesus Christ, the Virgin Mary and those most close to them.

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
