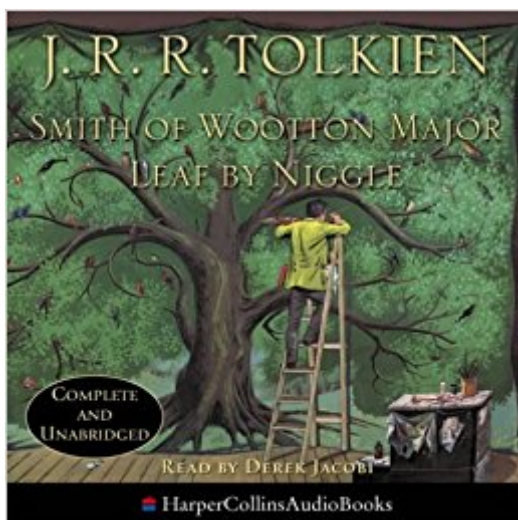

Though all ages would enjoy this, I think it has an enormous amount to say to adults.
