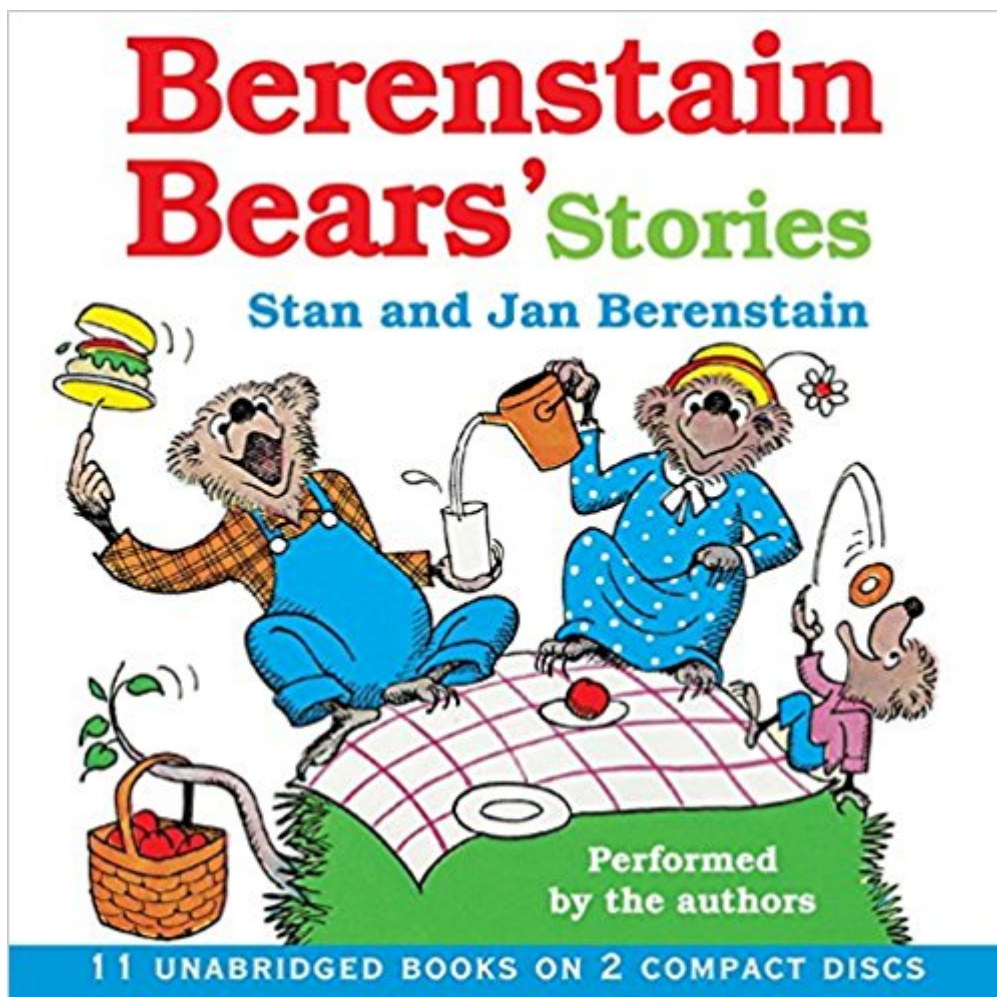

Jan Berenstain reads the parts of the polite bear son, as well as the practical mother bear. Her voice is endearing, sometimes gruff but always loving. Stan Berenstain reads the parts of the conceited and unrealistic father bear. His voice sounds smug, confident that his ideas and plans are always the smartest. Both authors read slowly, making this especially appropriate for young listeners, but all ages will enjoy the antics. I find this to be relaxing to listen to. My three girls all have this playing on their radios at night. They ask for it. Some might find the voices odd, but I imagine it is Stan and Jan themselves reading the stories. They are very entertaining.

Got this for road trips several years ago, when my kids were younger. The books are read by the authors, Stan & Jan Berenstain, rather than actors. I really enjoyed listening to them read; it is like listening to your grandparents! My boys really enjoyed these stories. This CD made long road trips much more BEARable!

First, let me say that we love the Berenstain Bears books, all of them. We did not like this audio cd. The voices of the characters were not good. They drove us crazy and made us want to turn them off. Maybe it was just us but we didn't like it.

Cute stories but the quality of the CD is terrible. The music is much too loud and I wish I had read the reviews before I ordered it. Listening to it in the car we had to keep turning down the volume because of the music and then up again to hear the stories. It was extremely annoying.

I'm a huge fan and love the books, but the reading by the authors is not very entertaining, and my 4 year old is not feeling it, and he loves when I play books on cd in the car, but not this one. Still a fan, will just stick to the books.
