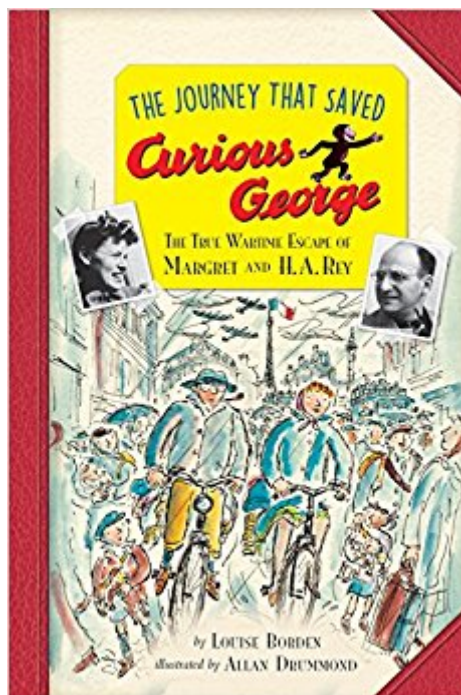

Louise Borden is the highly regarded author of many books, including Good Luck, Mrs. K!, Sleds on Boston Common, Good-bye, Charles Lindbergh and The Little Ships: The Heroic Rescue at Dunkirk in WW II, published by Margaret McElderry Books, and The Journey That Saved Curious George, Across the Blue Pacific, and His Name Was Raoul Wallenberg, published by HMH. The book was smaller than I expected, but I believe it has more content than many larger books. Borden certainly did her research, and she added a section at the end where she compares research to being a detective. This is a great way to educate and inspire children intellectually. The story is told with a vocabulary that children can understand while adults will still find it a good read. Borden included quite a number of drawings and photographs by the Rey's. She explains in an epilogue that she didn't write about the Holocaust for several good reasons: 1. It had nothing to do with the Rey's journey. 2. Very few people who didn't live near the camps actually knew what was going on at that time, and many didn't believe it. 3. She wanted children to have a small hint of the danger without writing a tale which might give them nightmares. She packs a great deal of information into this small book and I learned about several other books they produced. I enjoyed it greatly.

I wish I could read this book, but when I go beyond the cover, the person who produced it, placed two pages on each view. This makes the print too small to read without a magnifying glass. I hope you have a solution.
