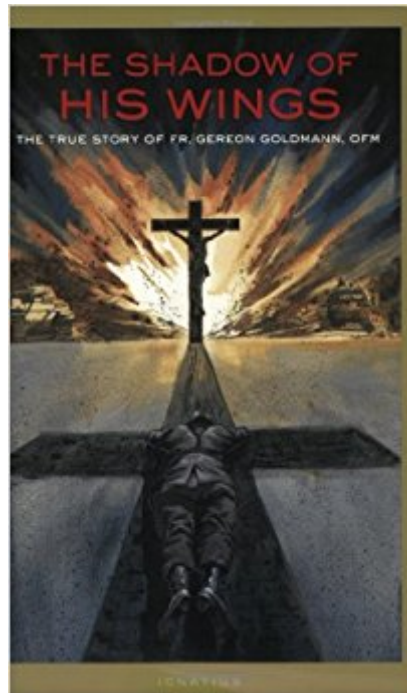




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The Shadow Of His Wings: The True Story Of Fr. Gereon Goldmann, OFM

With the unexpected help of nuns, bishops, and even the Pope, he was ordained a priest in the waning days of the war. The current edition includes the story of his later work as a missionary in post-war Japan. For believers, this is an inspiring story of God's providence allowing one man to touch the lives of many. But I think anyone can appreciate reading about a side of the war that is rarely, if ever, seen.

In light of all the controversy surrounding whether Pope Pius XII did enough for the Jews, and on the recent Papal apology for the past sins of the Church comes a book that demonstrates the actions of some in the face of Nazism. This true story follows the experiences of a young German seminarian, Gereon Goldmann, drafted into Hitler's SS in the beginning of World War II. The story tells how Goldmann, in the face of evil, was able to continue his training for the priesthood and minister to others. This is the best book of 2000!

This is an incredible account of a Catholic priest who also happened to be a Nazi. The encounters this priest experienced are amazing to say the least. How he served as a Catholic priest and the Nazi party simultaneously borders on the unbelievable. Fr. Geron's tenacity in adhering to his beliefs were much stronger than the Nazi dictates. Not once did he ever compromise his priesthood. Suffice it to say during his tenure while a Nazi soldier, he never fired even one shot. The lengths this priest endured in bringing the Blessed Sacrament to men in the battlefield are astounding. Equally heartwarming were the revelations of other Nazi soldiers who admitted to him their disdain for the Hitler regime. Even though you may not be a Catholic, I wholeheartedly encourage you to read this book to have some insight of the lengths one might pursue in practicing his beliefs regardless of seemingly insurmountable circumstance. I promise you, after you've read this book, you will have a different outlook on who you are as a person and what you are willing to acknowledge. Could serve a self

I estimate that I have read over 10,000 books (including audio books, manuscripts, screenplays etc). This book ranks in my top five favorite books for the following reasons:1. This book captures some great humorous moments during a very dark war.4. Helped me to see WWII from the viewpoint of a faithful Catholic who was promoted to the SS (read book before passing judgement). 5. Really demonstrates how God makes all crooked lines straight when you submit to His will.(Special Note: I also recommend reading "In Solitary Witness" by Gordon Charles Zahn for another great perspective.)

I saw a similarity between my journey through a godless modern age and Fr. Goldmann's journey as a German soldier during WWII's Nazi fascist state.
