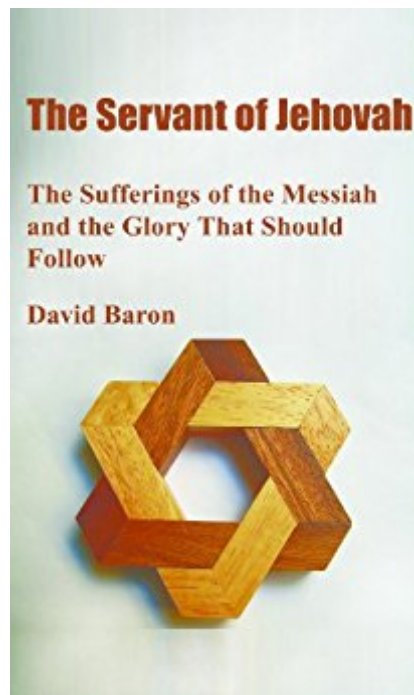




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# **The Servant Of Jehovah: The Sufferings Of The Messiah And The Glory That Should Follow**

This is a very good and significant book by a convert from Judaism who brings to his task of exposition particular knowledge of Jewish history and of the Old Testament. language and literature. That is a great advantage, but another is the directions he gives for further reading on the subject by the references he makes to other writers. He relies heavily on the book 'The Man of Sorrows and the Joy that was Set before Him' by an old Baptist scholar James Culross, a debt he recognises at one point, though quotations are not always recognised. I have both books and I value both highly. Careful reading of David Baron's book will give the reader a deeper insight into the profundities in Isaiah's prophetic oracle. Buy it and get Culross's book as well and treasure both. They will deepen your understanding of the atonement, your faith in and appreciation of the Saviour.
