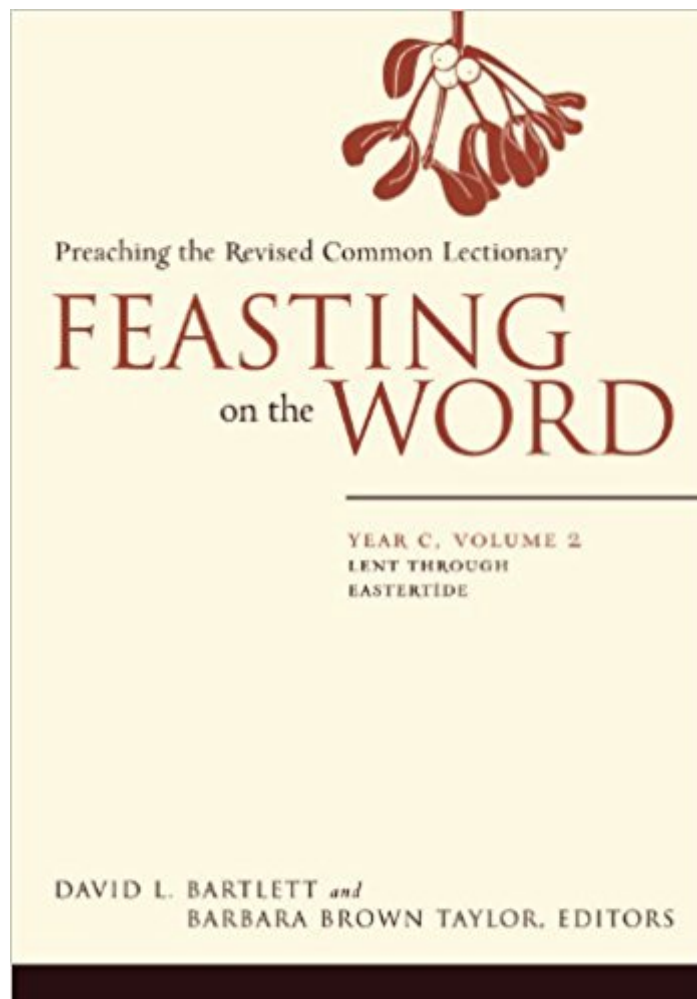


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Feasting On The Word: Year C, Volume 2: Lent Through Eastertide



Synopsis

With this new lectionary commentary series, Westminster John Knox offers the most extensive resource for preaching on the market today. When complete, the twelve volumes of the series will cover all the Sundays in the three-year lectionary cycle, along with movable occasions, such as Christmas Day, Epiphany, Holy Week, and All Saints' Day. For each lectionary text, preachers will find four brief essays--one each on the theological, pastoral, exegetical, and homiletical challenges of the text. This gives preachers sixteen different approaches to the proclamation of the Word on any given occasion. The editors and contributors to this series are world-class scholars, pastors, and writers representing a variety of denominations and traditions. And while the twelve volumes of the series will follow the pattern of the Revised Common Lectionary, each volume will contain an index of biblical passages so that nonlectionary preachers, as well as teachers and students, may make use of its contents.

Some of the contributors don't really resonate with me, but for the most part something will get me thinking. I find the information provided isn't material I would directly incorporate into my sermons, but it does generate some ideas that I can take in a similar direction. Not a lot of new thought on the scriptures, but it is presented well. Don't expect an in depth look at the text. It is more of a concise overview. The contributors do know their material and I would say you can trust their insights and understandings.

Feasting on the Word is an excellent resource for those of us who prepare sermons, as well as for the average person in the pew who wants extra information and insight into the scripture readings for the coming Sunday.

I just graduated from seminary last year and am collecting preaching resources. Feasting on the Word was recommended by several colleagues so I bought this volume (the current season) and started using it right away. It is a great resource! There are commentaries by a number of excellent scholars from various perspectives on each of the readings--kind of like getting four commentaries in one. The page format is a little clunky, because all four start on the same page as the reading and continue in columns, but once I got used to it, it was fine. I have found that having all the commentaries on all the readings for one Sunday together in one place has made it easier for me to connect more of the readings together in my preaching, using stories from the Old Testament reading, images from the Psalms, etc. that can help illustrate the Gospel reading we tend to focus on. It's making my preaching richer and better. I will be buying all the volumes as we work through the lectionary. I would also recommend this to non-lectionary preachers to use--there is an index to guide you, although you might have to buy the whole set to get the readings you are looking for, Very much worth the price.
