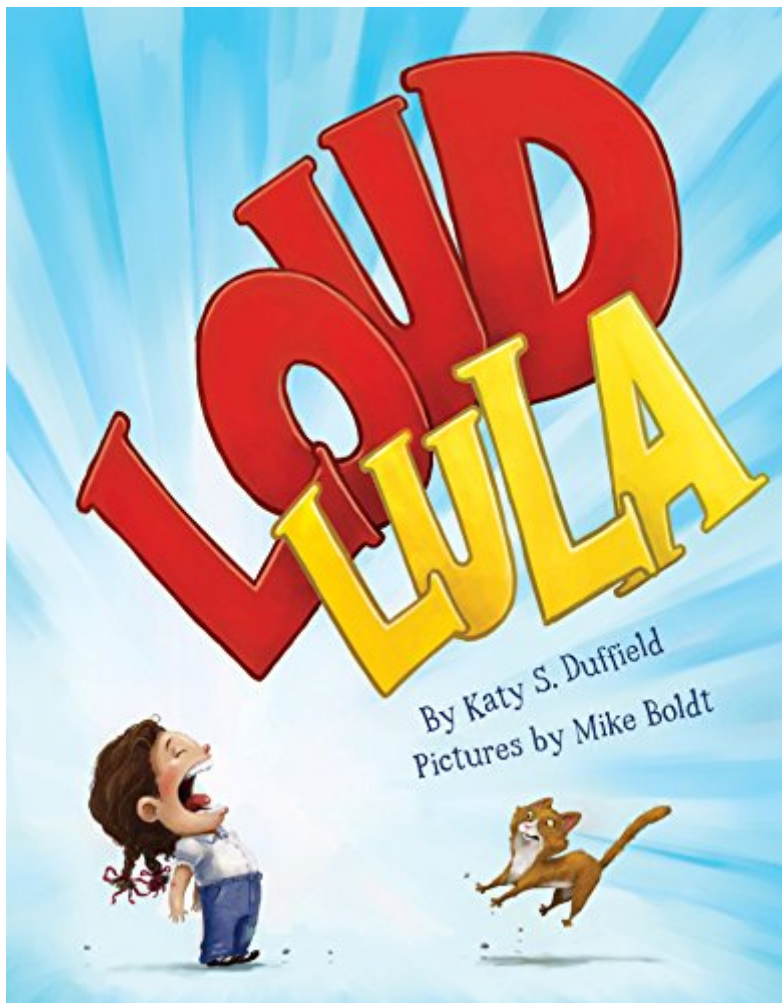

So while this story is not something I particularly liked, it was well received by the younger generation.

I love stories where a negative trait is shown to sometimes be a positive one. And this was a great
