

All the Hank the Cowdog books are great, and I would highly recommend them to kids and adults alike. They are so funny and especially good to have for road trips! It was good family time and kept us entertained until time for bed. They're also good for a child that needs some time to fall asleep. My husband used to listen to them as he went to sleep when he was a little boy. The way they're read doesn't rile a kid up. Hank is actually pretty monotonous and so even though the story is funny, it doesn't hype up the kiddos. This story in particular is a great read. Here's the synopsis from the Hank the Cowdog website: Sally May is planning to host a dance in her yard and launches a major Spring Cleaning Offensive! When a grumbling Slim is drafted to haul trash to the burn barrel, Hank decides it might be a good idea to keep an eye on him. He was right! Later, Miss Viola's pickup breaks down in front of Slim's house, and she needs Slim's expert help as a mechanic. Will the

bachelor cowboy take the opportunity to ask her to the dance or will the Head of Ranch Security have to take her to the dance?

Reading is often a chore to young boys. If you can't find the right book, then they won't read it. My boys hated the stories that were sentimental and would not read them. If a character was doing something he oughtn't my children would announce that he was going to get in trouble and they didn't want to read it anymore. Finally I ran across Hank the Cowdog books. Children don't get in trouble- dogs do! These are books that boys especially can relate to. I am happy we have these books around for my boys to read.

This is the second Hank the Cowdog audiobook I have bought, and now I am hooked! We will be buying all of them now. My kids love the books, and have even emailed the author who was so kind to reply. These stories are wholesome and entertaining for the whole family. My husband, who usually doesn't like listening to anything in the car, was wishing we had another CD when this one was over.
