

I love Shakespeare. I love *Shrew*. This version is not only badly formatted, it is missing all of Act II (my favorite part) but also Act III scene I. Also, the "illustrations" are just weird. What on earth does

I have always liked the Arden editions. However, they are becoming too academic-scholar orientated and less useful for general student use. With this edition, a plus over Brian Morris's Arden 2 is the inclusion in facsimile of "The Taming of A Shew," opening up good discussion of the possible absence in the 1623 Folio of later insertions of Christopher Sly. Apart from some updating that takes in recent productions of "The Taming of THE Shrew", there was little else that struck me as new.
